

One note on Professor Bertram Schefold's two papers

Theodore Mariolis

In his recent paper (October 2019), on the so-called transformation of labour values into prices, Professor Schefold states without evidence or explicit reference that:

Anwar Shaikh and his school have undertaken empirical investigations, in particular Theodore Mariolis and Lefteris Tsoulfidis (see Shaikh 2016). (Schefold, 2019a, p. 32)

In his slightly earlier paper (April 2019), on the so-called neo-Ricardianism, he states:

Um dies zu erklären, sind die Ergebnisse Anwar Shaikhs (2016, Kapitel 9) und seiner Schule und assoziierter Forscher wie Mariolis und Tsoulfidis (2014) nützlich. (Schefold, 2019b, p. 698)¹

These statements appear as a benediction of the scientific waters. However, regarding both my jobs and joint jobs on the topic (with my former (2006-March 2018) co-author Professor Lefteris Tsoulfidis, as well as, within the S.G.S.E.,² with Dr. Nikolaos Rodousakis, Dr. George Soklis, Antonia Christodoulaki, Fotoula Iliadi, Apostolis Katsinos, and Eugenia Zouvela), they are without hypostasis.
